The Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care covers the basics of childhood development and the care of children. On completion of the course you will have developed skills, knowledge and experience to support children to achieve their developmental outcomes in an early learning childcare centre.

It must be noted the CHC Community Services training package (for this qualification) mandates work placement as a component of assessment of any units undertaken. Students must complete 120 hours of work placement, as an assessment component for all units. Where placement is not undertaken, and is required as part of the assessment requirements, competency cannot be deemed.

Completing the VCE VET Early Childhood Program enables students to pathway into employment in a Childcare Centre, Early Learning Centre or in the Community Services sector as a child minding assistant. Completing the Certificate III offers career opportunities as a qualified assistant educator in day are setting for babies and children.

Students have the opportunity to partially complete the Certificate III over two years with credit towards the VCAL in the Industry Specific Skills Strand or the VCE credit to Units 1-4.
